The cost of a T1 differs dependent on the value of the goods actually being transported. This is due to the potential tax exposure that the guarantee is covering. The above covers the cost of a T1 guarantee, additional charges are applicable if an export declaration needs to be made, please see additional services page below.

What is a T1?

A T1 is a transit document which allows for goods which originated outside the European Union (including the U.K.) to move freely within the European Union.

Why do I need a T1?

Unless a shipment customs clears and the import taxes are accounted immediately for upon arrival in the EU, a T1 (transit guarantee) must be in-place to allow the shipment to enter the EU. The T1 acts as a bond to allow a shipment to leave the arrival quay/docks to travel to its final point of clearance where a formal customs clearance will take place and the T1 closed.

How does it work?

Any person acting as the principal of a transit movement must provide a guarantee to ensure payment of the customs duties and other charges if the requirements for a T1 document are not fulfilled.

The TAD bears the MRN number, both in numerical and barcode form. This document has to be closed in an inland border facility or a private facility in your end destination, at this point any VAT or Duty is payable.

Templates of these documents will be supplied by your Yes 2 Ship operator.

T1 Creation:

Yes 2 Ship Operator will create and open the T1 within 24 hours. The T1 has to be collected inperson by the haulier from a specified UK border facility office.

The T1 will last for a period of 3 days from the date of issue, each day thereafter will cost £25 per day.

Transit:

The haulier will make the transit time and will update the Yes 2 Ship operator if there are any delays.

T1 Closure:

The haulier will report to a specified destination inland border facility office to close the T1. this **MUST** be done otherwise fines will be issued.

Please note that prices are based on customs point-to-point shipments, as such if an outside non-approved party is used, a surcharge of £25 is applicable, unless otherwise agreed.

Required Documentation & Departure Information

To produce a T1 and an export declaration, we need the following documentation:

- CMR, shipping or consignment note.
- Commercial invoice/packing list specifying tariff codes, weight, value, quantity and origin of manufacture.
- U.K. export terminal and date and time of departure.
- UK registered & activated EORI number.
